**Roman Catholic View: Grace is Necessary**

Purgatory: A state of purification after death.

Indulgences: A means by which one can shorten a stay in Purgatory

Jesus’ work on the cross is necessary, but not sufficient.

Grace that is earned is not Grace

**What does the Bible Teach About Grace?**

We were dead in our sins. (Ephesians 2:1-3)

We deserved God’s wrath. (Ephesians 2:3)

Grace is the pardon for sin. (Ephesians 2:4-7)

Grace is not earned, but freely given. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

Grace alone is sufficient (Ephesians 2:8-9)

Works are a result of justification, not part of it. (Ephesians 2:10)

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
