

## Life at the Cross Roads, Which Road will you Choose?

### Matthew 7:13-14

*“Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.”*

### Introduction

Jesus is closing the Sermon on the Mount. He leaves his listeners with a choice. Either follow me, and have life eternal, or deny me and face eternal damnation.

### Two Choices

The narrow gate represents Jesus.

The narrow gate is exclusive.

The broad gate and the wide road lead to hell.

Salvation is a work of God, it is supernatural.

The fruit of your life will give evidence as to whether you are saved or not.

The true disciple will have a way of life that reflects the character and nature of God.

Jesus is giving you a choice, you will either pursue God and His things, or you will pursue the world and the things of the world, but you cannot do both.

Jesus has given us two choices, one leads to hell, the other leads to life.
