



POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR IMMANUEL HIGH SCHOOL BY SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

MISSION STATEMENT

To provide financial assistance for high school age students who desire to attend Immanuel High School, but due to financial hardship are unable to attend.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The student and/or family shall be members of RMBC or our Extension Churches or be presently attending our church for the past year and actively involved in the church program.
- Must be enrolled in Immanuel High School and be recommended by the School Principal or Counselor for financial assistance.
- Special consideration will be given to a student from single parent households.
- Must complete a Financial Assistance Application.

CONDITIONS OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Must demonstrate financial need.
- Financial assistance shall be for tuition only.
- Financial assistance shall be for one school year at a time. A new application must be completed each year.
- Student must demonstrate an effort to maintain a “C” average with no more than one “F” in order to continue receiving financial assistance.
- Student shall meet with representative of the Scholarship Committee to clarify any questions or issues, and to provide accountability and spiritual support for the student.
- All approved applications and the amount of the financial assistance will be conveyed by the Chair to the RMBC Business Manager/Treasurer. These funds are then paid directly to Immanuel High School.
